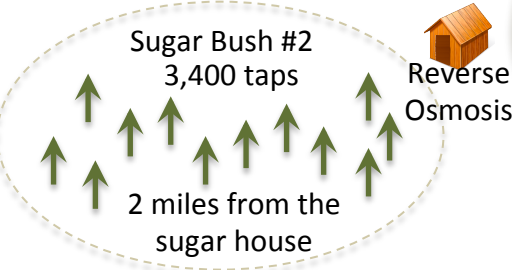


How it all works...

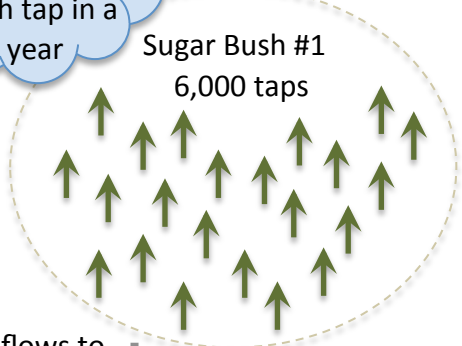
Four types of lines connect the maple trees to the sugar house. *Wet-Dry lines* are run together. *Wet lines* bring the sap to the sugar house and *Dry lines* are the vacuum system. A web of *Main lines* and *Drop lines* connect each maple tree to the *Wet-Dry lines*.



70-80 miles of tubing were used to tap the 9,400 trees

The ski-dozer pulls drums of sap from Sugar Bush #2 to the sugar house

15-20 gallons of sap run from each tap in a year



40 gallons of sap make one gallon of syrup
